Our mission at Baker Hunt Art & Cultural Center is to provide professional art instruction in a compelling learning environment for the enrichment of studies in the Arts & humanities. Position Summary:

Community Outreach Art Teachers are an extension of the Baker Hunt Art and Cultural Center. Baker Hunt brings art into the community through our Community Outreach programs by partnering with local schools and afterschool programs. Community Outreach Art Teachers will teach art lessons throughout the school year off-site at community locations.

This is a part-time contracted position. Several positions are available working with different age groups from preschool to high school. Time commitment is flexible depending on the number of classes the Art Teacher is able to teach. Classes average 2 hours per week. Most outreach positions are part of afterschool programs (3:00-5:30pm), with the exception of preschool positions, which are during the day.

Principle Responsibilities:

The Community Outreach Art Teacher is responsible for delivering weekly art instruction to kids at local partner schools. Responsibilities include:

- Developing students' interest, abilities, talents, and skills for artistic expression and creativity in the visual arts
- Fostering an appreciation for art and creativity within students
- Developing engaging lesson plans that translate to quality art experiences
- Managing supplies and requests for materials
- Maintaining communication with site coordinators
- Maintaining class records

- Teaching experience and/or art background required
- Exceptional classroom management skills
- Familiarity with a variety of art techniques and mediums
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines
- Ability to tailor lessons to the needs of the students and the time allotted
